Abstract

This Vietnamese village has a lot of important history as a shelter for Vietnamese, who requested asylum in Indonesia first, before finally being moved to Batam. With the various uniqueness of Kampung Vietnam, the author is interested in raising the topic, and making it into a final work in the form of a documentary video.

The concept that the author uses to make a documentary video about Vietnam Village is to use concepts from the Television Journalism 2 course. From these courses, which the author got while sitting in college, teaches how to raise an issue that is less important by society. The author conducted interviews with various parties such as one of them is Government Agencies.

Kampung Vietnamitself has the original name of Kampung Dukuh which was once a shelterfor Vietnamese people, which later turned into Trisna Wirda Nursing Home.

INTRODUCTION

History is something that proves that there are facts and evidence of the past occurrence of an event. One of the histories that the author wants to discuss is Kampung Dukuh, Kramat Jati, commonly known as Kampung Vietnam. This village has a long history that was first used as a shelter for Vietnamese people, before the Vietnamese refugees were finally moved to Galang Island, Batam, Indonesia until now. Then, the place was converted into a Trisna Wirda Foundation Nursing Home.

Mystical knowledge is irrational, that is the general meaning. The mystical meaning attributed to religion is the knowledge (teachings or beliefs) about God acquired through meditation or spiritual practice, without feelings and relationships. The author also chooses the project as a final work, and in the end chooses the topic of documentary video, because according to the author the project can be one of the more effective means to implement various courses, which the author has learned and obtained while sitting in college. Moral values are also found in the village, namely the values of civilization by respecting fellow humans and other creations of God in that place.

The next point that the author wants to convey is to increase the attention of the public related to Public Interest, because there are still many people who do not know an important history in the capital city of Jakarta. The history is the existence of Vietnamese refugee camps, whose places still exist today even though they are no longer habitable. However, according to the author, it deserves to be raised because of its uniqueness.

The author has also made observations several times before choosing Vietnam Village as the topic that the author wants to raise, by consulting with various parties, "is this Vietnamese Village already known by many people?" And in the end, the author concludes that there are still many people who don't know this, even though the place is in the middle of Jakarta. Therefore, the author also titled it "The Invisible Side in East Jakarta".

Another important point that the author wants to convey, namely in terms of the history of the place began, with some information that the author has found out before by conducting interviews with several parties. STEPS IN PREPARING PROJECT

In the process of making a video of the author's final work, it consists of three stages of video making, namely:

a. Pre-Production

In this stage, the author first identified our object, namely the Vietnamese Village in Kramat Jati, East Jakarta. The author also analyzes several of the author's video references, so that the author has an idea of the documentary video that will be made.

Then in the next stage, the author carries out project design. Where in this stage, the writer creates a script, storyline and storyboard, so that when shooting, of course it doesn't deviate from what has been planned. And in the process, of course the author held discussions with the supervisor first, so that the results that the author prepared were more mature.

The next process that the author carried out was to observe the shooting locations, namely Vietnam Village, of course to ask for permission first, and to determine the layout for shooting at a later date. Then, the author determines each talent and crew who will carry out the production process later, in order to avoid problems so that the resulting results are maximized.

The author also prepares equipment for future production needs, such as camera, lightning, microphone, gimbal and tripod. Some of the equipment that we obtained was also permitted and supported by Mr. Deavvy MRY Johassan, S.Sos., M.Si, to borrow some of the equipment to support our production needs, with the aim of ensuring that the audio and video produced would be optimal.

b. Production

At the production stage, after the author has carried out pre-production activities and preparations, the author carries out the production process. The author carries out the process of shooting and taking pictures, such as cinematic videos, time lapse videos, interview videos in accordance with the sequence that we have arranged in the storyboard, and shot-list. At this stage of production, the author did it within a period of 2 months, because many government agencies required permits and it took quite a long time before shooting could be carried out.

The production stage carried out by the author is to determine the right date to carry out the production process. After the date has been set, the team of writers, crew and talent carry out the shooting process at the location that has been determined and in accordance with the storyline that has been created. Shooting in 1 day was carried out from morning - afternoon, because of the various processes that had to be carried out during the process.

One of the processes carried out is preparing equipment for the production process, such as cameras. The camera must be adjusted first by selecting the right lens for each shot to be taken. Such as wide lenses and telephoto lenses. At this production stage, the author studied a lot of the theories he had learned by directly putting them into practice.

c. Post Production

After all the footage has been collected and all production requirements have been completed, the next stage is for the author to carry out the editing process which comes from the production materials that the author has taken. This editing stage was also carried out by one of our production crew, namely Muhammad Iqbal. The role of the editor has a very important role, because the editor determines the final result of a video that the author will make as the author's final work.

The editor here stitches and combines various footage and animations that the author has collected according to the storyboard that has been created, and of course the editor here is responsible for the author's video results. Therefore, we also interviewed government agencies directly related to this place which have the authority for future prospects regarding this place being used as a reservoir.

In making this video of our final work, we succeeded in implementing various course lessons that we learned while studying at college. Starting from the pre-production, production, to post-production stages. During the activity process, we have done various things such as determining ideas, looking for references, preparing equipment and talent, preparing storylines and storyboards, shooting, up to the editing stage.

The documentary video that we have made also contains four main elements, namely attractive (a video that is made as much as possible to make the audience comfortable and enjoy the video that we have made), original (the video that is made is original from the ideas and content that we created) , uniqueness (the video created is unique and distinctive compared to other existing videos), and value (the video created has positive values that can be conveyed to the audience).
